

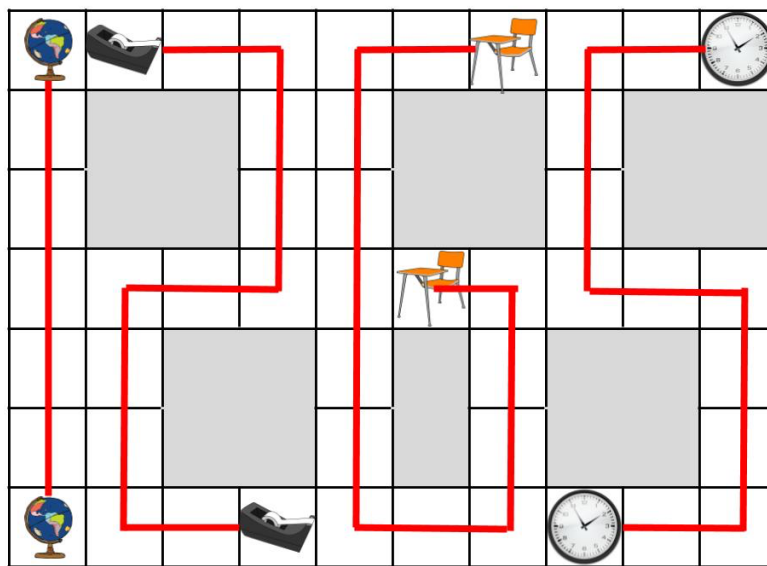
Escape the Classroom Answers

Password: AHOY

Simply write the password on the board once all students are logged in and ready to begin the game. This ensures that all students start at the same time.

Find the Key

Students will have to use this puzzle on their reference sheet. Students must draw a line connecting each picture with its match. Every square must be used only once. You cannot draw a line into a square that has already been used. A drawn line may not cross over another drawn line. When completed correctly, you will see 4 numbers.



Answer: 1265

Teacher's Desk

Students will have to find 2 hidden words in this picture, which will tell them what key unlocks the door. Their hint is to ignore the sharpies. The paper clips form the letter 's'. The scissors form the letter 'k'. The tape forms the letter 'e', etc...

Answer: SKELETON KEY



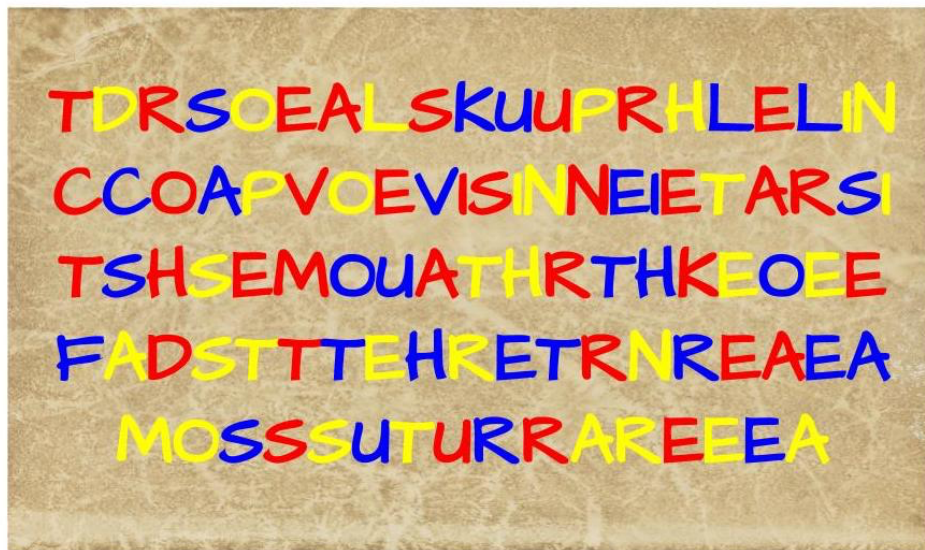
Colored Letters

To decode this, focus on each color separately.

Red letters: TREASURE COVE IS NEAR THE MARKED TREASURE

Yellow letters: DOLPHIN POINT IS THE EASTERNMOST AREA

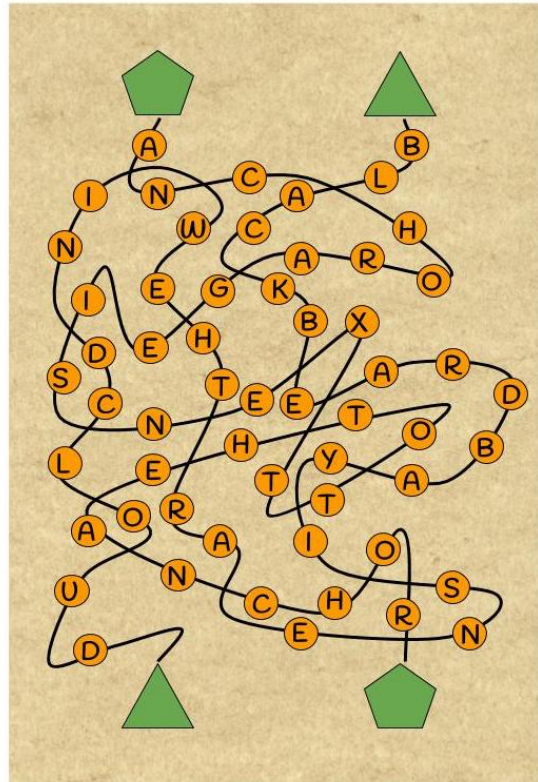
Blue letters: SKULL CAVE IS SOUTH OF THE TREASURE



Each color mentions a location. Students will need to find these locations on the map on the reference sheet and write them in.

Jumbled Letters

To decode this, students must carefully follow the lines. The letters found on the pentagon pathway will form a sentence. Similarly, the letters on the triangle pathway will form a sentence.



Pentagon: ANCHORAGE IS NEXT TO THE ANCHOR

Triangle: BLACKBEARD BAY IS NEAR THE WIND CLOUD

These are two more locations that can be found and written in on the map.

Riddle

“Five locations on the map. Write them down it’s not a trap.”

- The colored letters and the jumbled letters puzzles reveal the names and locations of 5 places. These need to be written down next to the correct dot on the map.

“Then, search for each place right below. Circle the letters when they show.”

- This hints at using the word search, which is right below the map on the reference sheet. Students must circle the 5 locations in the word search.

“Lastly, all J, M, Q, X, Z that you find cross them out, leave them all behind.”

-In the word search, cross out every single J, M, Q, X, and Z.

“Look closely at the remaining letters and all will be clear. Aha! At last, a message appears!”

-When the 5 locations have been found and all J, M, Q, X, and Z have been crossed out, the remaining letters will form a message. It will be helpful to write down all the remaining letters in order starting at the top.

Answer: TEACHER IS HELD CAPTIVE FOUR LEAGUES WEST OF ANCHORAGE

Finding location of teacher

Students must use their reference sheet to figure out how far a league is. One league is 3 miles, so 4 leagues would be 12 miles.

Next, students must use the map to figure out what location is 12 miles west of Anchorage.

Answer: BLACKBEARD BAY
