Here are some questions to ask students. These questions -- and others like them -- could be scaled up or down in complexity to meet the grade and ability levels of your students.

You might use them for discussions (class, small group, individual), as writing prompts, in projects, in debates, or in other ways.

- What are potential positive and negative impacts of AI on society?
- Which jobs are likely to be impacted by Al and in what way?
- What are things that make us unique as humans that Al can't do -- or can't do as well?
- How can Al help us with schoolwork without impeding our learning?
- How can AI help us in our work in different careers?
- What role do you think the creators of Al play in the responsible use of it?
- Could people use AI in unethical ways? Harmful or destructive ways even?

- Is it anyone's responsibility to stop people from using Al irresponsibly? Should it be the government's responsibility?
- What if we find that AI is biased or inaccurate? Should we still use it -- and to what extent?
- Should Al tools like ChatGPT be available to students and teachers (as long as they're old enough to use them under terms of service)?
