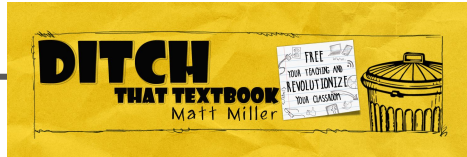




Digital escape room planning sheet

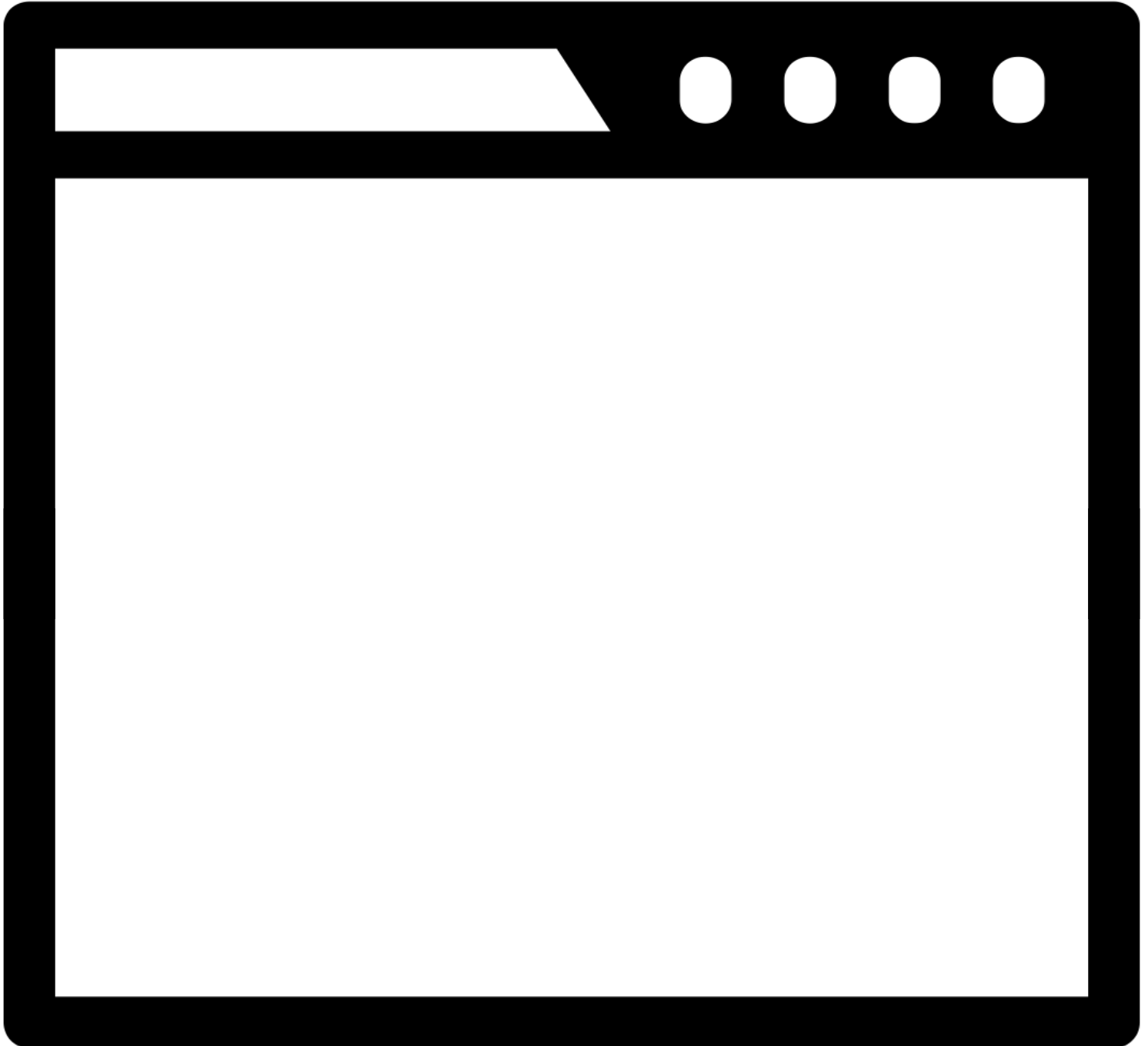
Create your locked form. Jot down which lock types you need to create locks for. Be specific so that your user knows what to type in the form.
