Knowing about some best practices in lesson planning and instructional design is helpful when generating lesson plans with AI!

Then, check out tip #4 (Let Them Create).

Steph asks ChatGPT to generate activities in all four levels of **Webb's Depth of Knowledge**.



BOOM. Better lesson plans again!

Some other lesson upgrades you can ask ChatGPT for:

- A variety of activities using **Revised Bloom's Taxonomy**
- Activities using Project Zero's **Visible Thinking Routines**

- Lessons that incorporate **the 21st Century Skills** (critical thinking, creativity, communication, collaboration)

Even if you aren't super familiar with these models, you can ask an AI assistant like ChatGPT for lessons with them.

If you like the result, use it!

If you like parts of it, keep those parts or modify.

If you don't like it, try something else!
